COST RECOVERY ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-001**

NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Please take notice that on December 11, 2023, Gibson Township (the “Township”) adopted Ordinance No. 2023-001 (the “Ordinance”), which allows the Township to recover costs incurred by the Township for providing public safety and fire emergency services; lists the associated costs; provides for an opportunity to appear before the Township Board and request modification of costs; reserves the Township’s right to pursue legal action for failure to pay; explains that individual provisions of the Ordinance are severable; prohibits finding Township Board members personally liable for actions taken under the Ordinance; and explains that all resolutions or ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed;

The Ordinance contains the following sections and catch lines: Section 1: Purpose; Section 2: Definitions; Section 3: Assessment of Costs; Section 4: Notice and Right to Appear Provisions; Section 5: Failure to Pay; Section 6: Severability and Captions; Section 7: Administrative Liability; Section 8: Repeal; Section 9: Effective Date, which is 30 days after this publication.
