A Public Accuracy Test of the digital scan voting equipment, which will be used in the May 5th, 2026 Special General Election, has been scheduled for **April 28, 2026 at 6:00 pm** at the Beaver Township Hall, 1850 S. Garfield Rd., Auburn, MI 48611.

The Public Accuracy Test is conducted to determine that the program and computer being used to tabulate the results of the election count the votes in the manner prescribed by law.

Please take notice that the Office of the Township Clerk will be open on Saturday, May 2nd, 2026 from 10 am to 2 pm and Sunday May 3rd, 2026 from 2 pm to 6 pm, to provide residents with the following services:

1. Registered Voters can request and vote an absent voter ballot in person.
2. Residents can register to vote with proof of residency. Voters who register to vote in person during the 14 days prior to the election, including on Election Day, must show proof of residency.
