Public Notice

Notice to Cut and Destroy All Grass and Noxious Weeds

Notice is hereby given that all grass and weeds on any land within Hampton Township must be maintained at a height of eight **(8) inches or less**. Grass and weeds not cut by May 15th of this year, and as often thereafter as necessary, will be cut by the Township. The property owner will be charged for the cost of mowing, as well as any costs related to the removal/relocation of debris, junk, or other obstructions that hinder enforcement of Ordinance 13-4. A \$100 administrative fee per cutting will also be assessed.

If the grass or weeds exceed the allowed height, the Township Supervisor, their designee, or an authorized contractor may enter the property to carry out the required work. This right of entry is expressly granted under Ordinance 13-4, and the Township and its agents shall not be liable for trespass.

Additionally, any owner, agent, or occupant who violates any part of this ordinance may be subject to a fine of up to \$500, imprisonment for up to 90 days, or both, at the discretion of the court. These penalties are in addition to the Township's right to enter the property and eliminate blight, including grass and weed control.
