Synopsis of Regular Meeting
July 11, 2023

The Board of Trustees of Williams Charter Township held a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, July 11, 2023.

The meeting was called to order by W. Butterfield, Supervisor at 7:00 p.m.

Present: W. Butterfield (Supervisor), T. Charbonneau (Treasurer), J. Putt (Clerk), J. Gower (Trustee), J. Plant (Trustee), S. VanTol (Trustee).

Excused: B. Jean (Trustee)

The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was said in unison.

Motion to add 6 items to the Regular Agenda. Motion carried.

Motion to accept the Consent Agenda, as presented. Motion carried.

Agenda Items

- Motion to waive reading of Ordinance 33, adopt and publish the rezoning of the Dow Property from Industrial and Commercial to Agricultural, which will take effect 31 days after publication. Motion carried.
- Motion to approve Tom Verellen as Mechanical/Plumbing Inspector at the same rate as Dell Bedford, including 15% pension. Motion carried.
- Motion to have Nine Mile, between Wheeler and Chip Roads, redone at the cost of \$65,000 Motion carried.
- Motion to approve up to \$5,000.00 for awnings for the township hall. Motion carried.
- Motion to add facia to the pavilion. Motion carried.
- Motion to have gutters added to the back of the DPW building, then trench to the ditch, not to exceed \$4,000.00. Motion carried.
- Motion to introduce, waive reading of Ordinance 33 and publish Ordinance 33 to amend the zoning ordinance to incorporate a duplex as proposed, keeping all other uses the same in the office zoning district. Motion carried.
- Motion to follow up on the sidewalks, both East Midland and West Midland, between Carter and Flajole and have Bay County Road Commission complete the design and engineering. Motion carried.
